Outdoor burns cannot contain the following items:

- Household trash
- Building & construction materials
- Tires & other rubber products
- Vinyl siding & shingles
- Plastics & other synthetic materials
- Roofing materials & shingles
- Paper products & cardboard

Kingston Springs & EPA actively work together to preserve local air quality. Violators can be cited to court and fined up to \$25,000.

Burn permits are required annually between October 15th & May 15th. Items that are allowed to be burned include:

- Leaves & vegetation
- Yard clippings & other types of brush
- Clean, untreated, & unpainted lumber
