Outdoor burns cannot contain the following items:

- Household trash
- Building & construction materials
- Tires & other rubber products
- Vinyl siding & shingles
- Plastics & other synthetic materials
- Roofing materials & shingles

Paper products & cardboard
Kingston Springs & EPA actively work
together to preserve local air quality.
Violators can be cited to court and fined
up to \$25,000.
