The Town of Kingston Springs has been named the 8<sup>th</sup> Safest City in Tennessee by ConsumerAffairs.com, an online consumer advocacy resource. The ranking was based on an analysis of five community indicators; burglary odds, change in burglary rate, number of police officers per capita, overall crime rate, and number of crimes per day.

“Our ranking is a result of the outstanding public safety services being provided to the community,” explained Mayor Tony Gross.

Along with the ranking, Kingston Springs was described as having the 28<sup>th</sup> best ‘crimes per day’ and the 170<sup>th</sup> best ‘police officers per 10,000 residents’ statistics in Tennessee.
