The Town of Kingston Springs has been named the 9th Safest City in Tennessee by Movoto.com, an online real estate resource. The ranking was based on a crime index score, which included such factors as; population, reported crime, incidents per capita, historic trends in reported crime, and locally available public safety resources. "The ranking is very exciting," explained Assistant City Manager Mike McClanahan. "It is the result of the involvement and participation of many residents, and the outstanding public safety services being provided to the community."

Along with the ranking, the town was described as:

"With numerous State Parks close by, Kingston Springs is a nice place to live, only 23 miles outside of Nashville. Kingston Springs is a town, home to around 2,700 people, and it's the ninth safest place to live in Tennessee. The crime index is 92" out of 100.
