A. Motion to approve Special Event Beer Permit Application – Amy/Cole Bruce, Skyking Pizza.

City Manager Lawless advised that the special event permit is part of Dinner on Main. Motion to approve Special Event Beer Permit Application – Amy/Cole Bruce, Skyking Pizza made by Vice-Mayor Remick, with a second by Commissioner Eatherly. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Motion to waive Special Event Permit Application fee – Skyking Pizza

City Manager Lawless stated that since Dinner on Main is a fundraiser for Kingston Springs Parks and Farmers and Artisan Market, staff is requesting the Board waive the special event permit fee. Motion to waive Special Event Beer Permit Application fee – Skyking Pizza made by Vice-Mayor Remick, with a second by Commissioner Eatherly. Motion passed unanimously.

C. Motion to approve Beer Permit Application – White Rock Restaurant Inc., 132 Petro Road, Kingston Springs, Tennessee.

City Manager Lawless said the application was received from White Rock Restaurant, Inc., doing business as Punjabi Dhaba. City Attorney Perry said they have satisfied all requirements for the permit. Motion to approve Beer Permit Application – White Rock Restaurant Inc., 132 Petro Road, Kingston Springs, Tennessee made by Vice-Mayor Remick with a second by Commissioner Hargis. Motion passed unanimously.

D. Underage Sales Violation – Thorntons LLC – 120 Luyben Hills Road, Kingston Springs, Tennessee. Kingston Springs Beer Permit 6-2-2019-1.

City Manager Lawless said on May 21, 2021 the Cheatham County Sheriff's Office conducted an underage beer buy operation across Cheatham County. Thorntons was in violation and was notified to appear in General Sessions Court. The disposition of that court appearance has been rescheduled. Thorntons representative Scott Morgan said they were aware of the violation. Clerk was terminated and team members will be going back through training. This was the first violation for this location. City Attorney Perry said there is a penalty limit of \$1,000 for Vendors that have earned title of Responsible Vendors and clerks have been through training. The Town had submitted a request to TN ABC board to inquire about Responsible Vendor status, but had not yet received an answer. Mr. Morgan was not aware if Thorntons was a Responsible Vendor, but would

look into becoming one if not already. City Attorney Perry said the board could either table their decision since the case had been delayed and we were still waiting on response regarding Responsible Vendor status, or it could fine up to the Responsible Vendor limit. Commissioner Eatherly stated that we had set a precedence of \$500 for first offense, he motioned that the clerk was at fault for having made the underage sale and fine Thorntons \$500 for the underage sales violation. Commissioner Clark asked if we had to wait for outcome of the Responsible Vendor inquiry. The outcome would affect the amount of the fine, and this fine is below the limit. Commissioner Hargis seconded the motion. Roll call vote was held with Commissioner Clark voting yes, Commissioner Eatherly voting yes, Mayor Gross voting yes, Commissioner Hargis voting yes, and Vice-Mayor Remick voting yes. Motion passed.

E. Underage Sales Violation – Sudden Service #13 – 129 Luyben Hills Road, Kingston Springs, Tennessee. Kingston Spring Beer Permit 3-19-2020-1.

City Manager Lawless again said on May 21, 2021 the Cheatham County Sheriff's Office conducted an underage beer buy operation across Cheatham County. Steve Glidewell, Tri Star Energy/Sudden Service representative, stated that they were a Responsible Vendor, and employees received training regularly, as well as having to sign the responsible vendor act monthly. He questioned how the sting operation was handled by the Sheriff's Department. He said the cashier was fired, per company policy. City Attorney said since he affirmed that they were a responsible vendor and this was a first offense for this operator, the board could either wait on court disposition on the case or make a decision to fine based on letter from County Sheriff. Employee has a court date of September 9. Commissioner Eatherly motioned to table the decision until court disposition would be known, with a second from Commissioner Hargis. Roll call vote was held with Commissioner Clark voting yes, Commissioner Eatherly voting yes, Mayor Gross voting yes, Commissioner Hargis voting yes, and Vice-Mayor Remick voting yes. Motion passed. Motion to move hearing to October made by Commissioner Eatherly, with a second by Commissioner Hargis, motion passed.

On May 21, 2021, The Cheatham County Sheriff's Office conducted an underage beer buy operation in Cheatham County. This operation was conducted using eighteen (18) to twenty (20) year old confidential informants. On this date forty-eight (48) retail establishments in Cheatham County were visited and the confidential informants attempted to purchase an alcoholic beverage. As a result of this operation four (4) establishments allowed our confidential informants to successful complete a purchase for alcoholic beverages. Those establishments are as follows:

PIERCE, TONY

On May 21st, 2021, between the hours of 1700 and 2000, The Cheatham County Sheriff's Office conducted an underage beer buy operation. As a part of this operation, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated 39-15-413, all retail establishments in Cheatham County that sell alcoholic beverages were visited and an underage (aged 18-20 year old) confidential informant entered each of the establishments and attempted to purchase an alcoholic beverage. Each of these attempts were recorded by video recording device and the identity of the listed clerks was compared with the video to establish identification. As a result of this operation, 4 stores were found to be in non-compliance with Tennessee Code Annotated 57-5-301, Sale of Alcohol to Underage Persons.

The Following Stores were found to be non-compliant by allowing an underage person to complete a purchase of an alcoholic beverage.
