



Are you asking yourself... *Do I need a Permit for that?*

Construction or alterations to structures or property in the Town of Kingston Springs may require a permit.

Permits are required for the following projects:

(Most permit needs apply to both Residential and Commercial projects.)

- New Construction – Residential and Commercial
- Building Additions
- Accessory Buildings
- Building Remodeling
- Structural Alterations
- Swimming Pools (all in-ground, *and* above ground pools over 24 inches deep)
- Hot Tub / Spa
- Fences over 6 feet in height
- Decks
- Attached or Detached Garages
- Sheds, Storage buildings or other Accessory Buildings
- Retaining Walls over 4 feet in height
- Signs
- Demolishing or Moving a Structure
- Driveways
- Excavation or Grading
- Street Cuts
- Temporary Use (tents, construction trailers, PODS)
- Firework Sales
